ABOUT

ACCESS to Independence has a vision for full inclusion of people with all types of disabilities in all aspects of community life, including the world of art and creative expression. With that in mind, we are looking for artists who share this vision.

We would like to invite artists with disabilities in Wisconsin to submit up to 2 works of art for this year's Artists Beyond Boundaries Event. On the evening of October 24th, ACCESS will host a dinner, as well as an exhibition of all artwork that has been submitted according to event guidelines. This dinner and exhibition will take place at the Concourse Hotel in Madison, Wisconsin.

AWARDS

All awards will be presented on the night of October 24th

Featured Artists (12 Awards)

A panel of judges will select 12 Featured Artists Awards. These artworks will be included in a 2020 calendar. Each recipient will receive a \$200 Award

People's Choice Award (1 Award)

Event attendees will have the opportunity to vote for a "People's Choice" award, which will consist of works which have not been selected by the panel of judges. The artwork awarded The People's Choice will be featured on the calendar's cover. The recipient will receive a \$200 Award

WHO CAN SUBMIT ART?

Any person with any type of disability and of any age.

WHAT TYPE OF ARTWORK CAN I SUBMIT?

Artists may submit up to 2 works of art which may be 2D and 3D in ceramics, mixed media, acrylic, oil, watercolor, drawing, prints, photography, digital media, collage, sculpture, and textiles. **All 2D artworks must be framed or mounted.** Other mediums may be considered, so call or email for inquiries.

HOW SHOULD ART BE SUBMITTED?

1) All art must be submitted with a completed application. Applications can be found on our website at www.accesstoind.org under the “News and Events” tab.

2) After completing the application by printing and mailing or through the online form, artwork can be submitted in one of two ways:

2a) Artwork may be dropped off at Access to Independence’s office located at 3810 Milwaukee Street in Madison, Wisconsin Monday-Friday from 8:30am-4:30pm.

2b) Artwork may be mailed in. **If mailed, artwork must be sent with return postage equal to the amount charged to mail it in.** Artists may choose to instead pick up their art at the event on October 24th or at the ACCESS office M-F from 8:30-4:30pm until November 24th, 2019

***All art must be postmarked by August 31st**

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER ART IS SUBMITTED?

A panel of judges will select 12 works of art to be included in a 2020 calendar. Award recipients and artist whose works were not selected will be notified on September 20th. All artwork submitted will be included in a one night exhibition on October 24th at the Madison Concourse Hotel in Madison, WI.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO ATTEND THE EVENT?

All artists (up to 50 total) who submitted art will receive two free tickets to attend. Additional tickets are \$45.00 each. Registration and payment options for all others tickets will be available on our website on September 20th.

CAN I SELL MY ART?

Artists are welcome to discuss the sale of their art at the event, but any transactions must occur separately from the event. Access to Independence is not liable for any transactions
